About the venue

The main hall, Aulan, normally hosts 360 persons, but is restricted to 50 persons in the audience (presenters not included). All presentations are also possible to follow online.

Plantan is restricted to 14 attending participants on site (+speaker).

The Crafoord hall (transferrable skills) is located a 500 m walk from Aulan. It normally hosts 117 persons, but is restricted to 50 persons. The program items following the transferable skills will be broadcasted to the Crafoord hall.

Places in all halls will be available on a first come first serve basis. Places will be prepared in other lecture halls for on site attendees to sit with their computers to participate online.
